Electric Cars Europe (ECE)

Hot news from The Netherlands! There will be a new car manufacturer creating electric cars, one of the first being an electric version of the Lotus Elise!

Electric Cars Europe is a joint venture of the Dutch Lotus distributor Van der Kooi Sportscars, Innosys Engineering, United Momentum Group (investor) and energy supplier Essent.

Production of the electric version of the Elise is planned to start in July 2008 in a 3500 square meter assembly facility in the town of Lochem (NL).

Some numbers:

0-100 km/h in 4,7 seconds, top speed 215 km/h, action radius 325 km on fully charged batteries, charge time will be 10 hours.

Price: EUR 108.750,=

Essent plans to create several loading stations where the batteries will be charged in 10 minutes.

ECE will also become European distributor for Detroit Electric. An example of a car made by Detroit Electric is the Zap X, a crossover electric vehicle with room for 7 persons. This car is based on the Lotus APX concept car, with electric engines in the wheels producing a total of 480 kW. This car will have a planned action radius of 560 km, a top speed of 250 km/h and 0-100 km/h will take about 5 seconds.....

Price: EUR 71.400 euro.
