Autosport reported that Lotus Racing will use the old Team Lotus name, starting next year. The story is that team boss Tony Fernandes purchased rights to use the name from former owner David Hunt. The official announcement will come during the Singapore GP.

## Lotus – Toyota relationship

Lotus commemorated their successful relationship with Toyota on the 17<sup>th</sup> of September at a celebration at the British Embassy in Tokyo where Lotus CEO Dany Bahar presented Toyota Motor Corporation President Akio Toyoda with a specially equipped Lotus Elise powered by the last ever Toyota 2ZZ-GE VVTL-i engine. The 2011 model year Elise R is white with a black interior. The occasion marked the end of an era and the start of an even stronger relationship between the two companies.



President Toyoda was also presented with a commemorative plaque encased in a leather wallet alongside the keys to the Lotus Elise R housing the final Toyota 2ZZ-GE engine produced: serial number 2ZZ 0188375.

As part of the celebration, Lotus CEO Dany Bahar said: "The presentation of Toyota's last 2ZZ engine in the Elise is a symbolic gesture of our continued respect and deep appreciation for our partner not only acknowledging our past but also looking forward to our future together."

Toyota Motor Corporation President Akio Toyoda responded: "A Toyota engine in a Lotus car creates a completely unique drive feeling – a special blend featuring the best of Lotus and Toyota that we hope many

car lovers continue to experience and enjoy."

Just moments after this President Akio Toyoda, unable to wait any longer, took his new toy and Dany Bahar for a spin around the British Embassy much to the delight of the waiting media.

Based on the successful cooperation with Toyota so far, Lotus has decided to take the relationship with Toyota to a new level that will enable Lotus to create tailor-made powertrain solutions for future Lotus cars.

For more details on exactly how Lotus will be partnering with Toyota in the future, simply look to the Lotus global unveiling at the Paris Motor Show on September 30th where Lotus will showcase their new line up to the world's media. The eagerly anticipated event marks the dawn of a new era for Lotus and will highlight exactly why both companies are so proud of their relationship.

### **State of California recognises Lotus as expert in lightweight vehicles**

The State of California awarded \$2 million research programme to Lotus Engineering for a study into efficient, lightweight cars of the future. Lotus Engineering will conduct a detailed structural design and analysis of the prototype vehicle from an earlier study to demonstrate it meets the crashworthiness and stringent safety requirements for vehicles sold in the United States.

In April this year, Lotus Engineering concluded the first part of the study, released by the International Council on Clean Transportation in California, which recognised that a reduction in vehicle mass of 38% can be achieved for medium volume vehicles (around 50,000 units a year) with just an increase in 3% in vehicle cost and giving a 23% reduction in fuel consumption.

This study will be led by Lotus Engineering's Michigan, USA office with completion in April 2011. The vehicle design will use a mixture of materials best suited to its application including aluminium, magnesium, composites, high strength lightweight steel and plastics.

### **Lotus-Renault?**

September 8, 2010. Will history be repeated? Rumours, I have to admit. It is said that Lotus Racing was not happy with the gearbox in the T127 and was looking for a new supplier of gearboxes and transmissions for next year. It looks like Renault is happy to cooperate. But Renault did also bring their engine to the attention of the team. According to Autosport a deal has been agreed in principle for Lotus to get the Renault customer engines for 2011. If that will happen, the team will receive the same specification of power-unit as Red Bull Racing. And Lotus and Renault will be working together in Formula One after 25 years, as the last time this happened was 1986.

Cosworth general manager of F1 operations Mark Gallagher said: "As with the other new teams, Lotus has a fixed term three-year contract with Cosworth and we are very pleased it is happy with our engines and the job we have done for it during its first season in Formula 1."

Comments of Mike Gascoyne: "We've got a contract with Cosworth and there is no further comment to make."

### **Lotus-Renault?(2)**

September 13, 2010. The story is now continued, here is a statement by Cosworth:

Cosworth and Lotus Racing have reached agreement in principle to end their three-year F1 contract at the end of the current season.

Lotus Racing is known to have been in negotiation with another supplier for some time, seeking a

deal which also includes provision of a gearbox.

A recent statement confirmed: "Cosworth has reached an agreement in principle with Lotus Racing whereby the team's Cosworth engine supply agreement will come to a conclusion at the end of the current Formula One season. This agreement is subject to contract and until the agreement is signed, neither party will be making any further comment."

Now that the deal with Cosworth will be terminated, Lotus is free to use engines, gearboxes and transmissions from Renault, that is also supplying to Red Bull Racing.

But....

The Italian language Autosprint reports that Lotus could actually announce a technical cooperation with Toyota Motorsport, that raced in Formula One between 2002 and 2009. Several former members of Toyota's F1 team are now working with Lotus, such as sporting director Dieter Gass.

"We have to do something different and it will be done soon," team boss and owner Tony Fernandes told the BBC at Monza last weekend.

"Lots of negotiations have gone on over the last couple of weeks and we're very happy with the outcome," he added.

### **FIA announces 20 Formula One races for 2011**

Formula One racing's governing body, the FIA, has released the calendar for the 2011 world championship. The addition of the Indian Grand Prix makes for a 20-race season - one more round than in 2010 and the longest in Formula One history.

The Bahrain Grand Prix will kick off proceedings on March 13, followed by the Australian, Malaysian and Chinese rounds, before the championship heads to Europe. The inaugural Indian event will take place towards the end of the year on October 30, with the season drawing to a close in Brazil on November 27.

Whilst the 2010 calendar features three back-to-back races, the 2011 season will have four, with the Malaysia/China, Spain/Monaco, Germany/Hungary and Japan/Korea events all taking place on consecutive weekends.

**Matchbox** has just released an other version of their 1/64 **Lotus Europa**, this time it is green.





The following model was seen by one of the readers, a SMTS Europa S1 with special decals to resemble the car that once drove the Targa Florio
